The Zanesville Museum of Art Is Reopening September 15, 2021

ZANESVILLE, Ohio– The Zanesville Museum of Art is reopening to the public September 15, 2021. The museum has been temporarily closed since October 2020 to conduct a full inventory of the permanent collection as well as in response to the ongoing health emergency. The hours upon reopening will be Wednesday 10–5, Thursday 10–7, and Friday 10–5.

“I look forward to seeing guests back at the museum,” stated ZMA Executive Director Laine Snyder. “Despite the recent setback presented by the Delta variant of COVID-19, the museum is taking steps to ensure we provide a safe environment for our visitors and staff.”

Visitors will be able to view recent acquisitions and works from both the permanent collection and temporary exhibitions, including

- *The Weller Hudson State Vases from the Permanent Collection*
- *Modern Morality | The Prints of William Hogarth*
- *The Mark and Kim Moyer Collection*
- Recent American Art Pottery acquisitions, and
- Handturned works crafted by local artisan Wilbur Mock

The Collection Inventory Project will continue when the museum reopens and guests will be able to view the progress in person. The project will create greater accessibility to the 8,000+ collection through a web-based, searchable digital database.

The ZMA will be continuing online programming when it reopens, including the popular Minute with a Masterpiece, ZMA Puzzler, and ZMA Photo Hunt series. Guests can enjoy online programming on the ZMA's Facebook page and at zanesvilleart.org. In-person programming will resume in the future.
