Pivoting



Here are a few ways you can pivot like an expert. What is a pivot? It is a statement used in a tour to move your guests physically and psychologically from one work of art to another. Here are a few of our favorite pivots...what are yours?

- "That is intriguing." "What do you see that is <u>similar / different / as exciting / as</u> <u>colorful / as heart wrenching / as funny</u> (fill in the blank) in this work over here?" ...As you lead them to the next work on your tour.
- "Another work that has similar characteristics..." ... As you lead them to the next work on your tour.
- "I'd like to show you another example..."
- "What other work in this gallery\_\_\_\_\_\_ (fill in the blank)?" Tip: To ensure you get the answer you expect, if that's critical to you and your tour, be sure to ask a specific question rather than an open-ended question, e.g., a specific question might sound like, "What other work in this gallery was painted by artist Misty Johnson?" A general question might sound like, "What other work in this gallery is beautiful?"
