## The Zanesville Museum of Art Receives Largest Donation from Beaux Arts Club

ZANESVILLE, Ohio-The Zanesville Museum of Art recently received a \$33,000 donation from its affiliate group, the Beaux Arts Club. The donation represents the largest ever donation from the Beaux Arts Club to the museum. The money will be used to help accomplish the museum's basic mission, including holding educational programs and displaying new and exciting exhibitions for the public.

"The donation comes from the net proceeds of last summer's annual Beaux Arts Art in the Garden Gala," says Beaux Arts President Karen Baker. The Gala is one of many fundraising events the Club holds to raise money for the museum.

The Beaux Arts Club was founded in 1954 and currently has 48 members. These members range from young professionals to active retirees and all have a desire to help the museum. The Club is its own 501c3, and its main mission is to support the Zanesville Museum of Art. The donations from the Beaux Arts Club have allowed the ZMA to purchase new artwork, display cases, and even provide scholarship money for children's art classes. The Beaux Arts Club also supports the "Adopt a Masterpiece" initiative.
