

MUSKINGUM COUNTY K–12 STUDENT ART EXHIBITION Guidelines

Artwork Selection

- Include as many students as possible.
- **Each student may only be represented twice. The second piece must be a different medium.**
- Select a wide variety of projects.
- 3-D work must be able to stand on its own.
- The museum **cannot** accept works that contain glitter.

Artwork Preparation

- For works on paper, mount on construction paper with a 2-inch border.
- Attach the identifying label on the bottom right corner of each piece.
- For canvas and 3-D media, include identifying information on the back or bottom of the piece and have a label ready to affix to the wall or pedestal.
- No framed work will be accepted.

Inventory

- Complete an inventory sheet that includes all of your submissions.

Drop-off

Deliver artwork and inventory sheet to the Zanesville Museum of Art during the following times:

- **Friday, April 12, 2024 from 12 pm–5 pm**
- **Saturday, April 13, 2024 from 12 pm–5 pm**
- By appointment with ZMA education coordinator, Misty Johnson (740) 452-0741 ext. 202.

The deadline for submissions is Saturday, April 13 by 5 pm.
