The Zanesville Museum of Art Is Opening July 7–9

ZANESVILLE, Ohio— The Zanesville Museum of Art is opening its doors for three days only, Wednesday through Friday, July 7–9, from 10 am to 7 pm to welcome pottery enthusiasts and the general public. The museum will close again afterwards to finish a site-wide collection inventory.

"Each year, we are excited to welcome pottery enthusiasts to the museum," stated executive director Laine Snyder. "They are such an enthusiastic and supportive audience for the ZMA."

Pottery enthusiasts meet in Zanesville annually to sell, purchase, and learn more about art pottery in the city that was known in the 19th century as the "pottery capital of the world."

This year, the ZMA has two exciting art pottery exhibitions from two extraordinary collections: The first is *Rare Finds | The Mark and Marie Latta Collection* which features unusual examples from Weller, Roseville, Rookwood among other Ohio pottery manufacturers. This exhibition closes at 12 pm on Friday, July 9, 2021. The second exhibition features pieces collected by Zanesville natives, *The Mark and Kim Moyer Collection*. In addition, the ZMA will exhibit recent art pottery acquisitions. Guests visiting the museum can also view the progress of the ongoing Collection Inventory Project at the ZMA.
