Zanesville Museum of Art Opening Watercolor Exhibition

ZANESVILLE, Ohio— The Zanesville Museum of Art opened a new exhibition in its Linn auditorium titled "A Luminous Medium | Watercolor Paintings from the Permanent Collection."

Featuring sixteen watercolor paintings from the ZMA's permanent collection, this exhibition includes the Ohio artists Richard J. Phipps (1928–2005), Frederick Bennet Leach (1924–2006), Charles L. Peterson (1927–2020), George K. Marquis (1908–1990), Estelle Derner (1922–1990), Byron Kohn (1926–2010), and Hal Scroggy (1921–2018). In addition, this show features the work of Zanesville watercolorists Charles L. Dietz (1910–2002), Ida S. Kaufman (1911–2001), Juanita S. Williams (1933–2016) and Michael Seiler. Although stylistically different, varying from naturalistic to abstract, the paintings in this exhibition convey the technical skills required to push the boundaries of watercolor and render the subtleties of the natural world.

This exhibition is on view in the ZMA's Linn Auditorium now through January 13, 2023.
