The Zanesville Museum of Art Receives Funding from Ohio Arts Council

ZANESVILLE, Ohio–The Zanesville Museum of Art has received a significant grant from the Ohio Arts Council. The Council's Board approved 679 grants during it's July 25 board meeting, totaling over \$12 million dollars in grants. The ZMA's Sustainability grant allows the museum to pursue mission-related programs and exhibitions.

"OAC funds allow the museum to reach a broader audience, said Executive Director Laine Snyder, "and deliver more meaningful programs. Over the last several years, as a result of their continued support, the OAC has redefined our programs and reshaped the direction of the ZMA."

Sustainability grants from the Ohio Arts Council support ongoing arts and cultural activities in all genres. Awards support the largest and most administratively sophisticated organizations in the state's arts and culture ecosystem. This four-year funding positions Ohio as a national leader in creativity, artistry, and cultural wealth.
