Zanesville Museum of Art Preparing to Open Statewide Juried Exhibition

ZANESVILLE, Ohio–The Zanesville Museum of Art will open the annual, state-wide, juried 74th Ohio Annual exhibition, at the museum, Thursday, June 20, at 5:30 pm. There will be live music by the Brady Israel Trio, complimentary light bites, and a cash bar.

The Ohio Annual exhibition celebrates the Zanesville Museum of Art's commitment to discovering, encouraging, and recognizing Ohio's finest artists and artisans. It brings together some of the best artists in Ohio and celebrates artistic excellence in the Buckeye State.

This year, 224 artists all over Ohio submitted 353 works for consideration. Only 49 artists were selected to be in this prestigious exhibition, including three from Muskingum County. This is a significant example of the thriving arts community in the Zanesville area. This artistic achievement is what the Ohio Annual celebrates at the ZMA.

Nora Daniel is one of the artists accepted into the Ohio Annual from Zanesville. Daniel, a member of the Artist Colony of Zanesville, is known for her oil paintings, which people recognize from the First Friday Downtown Art Walks in Zanesville. Daniel is well-known in the Zanesville arts community.

The ZMA is honored to have distinguished guest juror, Scot Phillips, Operations Officer, Massil-Ion Museum, select this year's participants and award a \$1,000 prize for Best in Show. Mr. Phillips along with ZMA Executive Director Laine Snyder will present the awards during the exhibition opening at 6:00 pm. The museum would like to thank the Beaux Arts Club, the ZMA's affiliate group, who will present The Mrs. Janice Ballas Excellence in Fiber Arts Award and a \$250 prize to one outstanding guilt-maker, textile, or fiber artist. The museum will also recognize and present \$100 awards in Painting; Drawing, Prints, and Collage; Sculpture; Jewelry and Functional Metalwork; Ceramics; Glass; and Photography.

The ZMA invites everyone out to the opening of this exhibition on Thursday, June 20, 5:30 pm. The Ohio Annual exhibition will be on view at the museum through September 7, 2019.
