Sculpture From the Permanent Collection Opens September 23, 2016 at the Zanesville Museum of Art

ZANESVILLE, Ohio – The Zanesville Museum of Art is opening its newest exhibition, entitled *Sculpture From the Permanent Collection* on September 23, 2016. This exhibition is ongoing and is located in the Golden Gallery.

The exhibition features figurative and abstract sculptures from the museum's collection. These stunning three-dimensional works range in date from 500 BC to modern day. The works in this exhibition have roots in classical form, and some of them have never been on view.

The sculptures on view are often associated with the Greeks and Romans who wanted to emulate the beauty of the human form, which resulted in truly wonderful marble sculptures that honor mythical gods. Featuring works from Europe and America, these sculptures exhibit this beauty in its purest form.

The Golden Gallery's vaulted ceilings and natural lighting highlight the sculptures and help people appreciate the design of these three-dimensional works. This stunning gallery is on the third floor of the museum.

The Zanesville Museum of Art will also be holding a Gallery Talk, entitled "From Neoclassicism to Abstraction" from 12-1 pm on Wednesday, November 16th, 2016. This is an opportunity for anyone interested to learn more about these beautiful works of art.
